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# County Treasurer seeking owners of nearly \$300K in unclaimed refunds!

*1,288 San Diegans have 60 days to claim the money*  
*Claims deadline: September 23, 2013*

*San Diego, CA* ...San Diego County Treasurer-Tax Collector Dan McAllister announced today that his office is seeking property taxpayers and others who may have done business with any County department in the past four years to review the Unclaimed Monies list at: [www.sdtreastax.com](http://www.sdtreastax.com). Otherwise the remaining unclaimed funds will be “escheated” to the County’s General Fund.

“Each year, our team at the Treasurer-Tax Collector’s office works very diligently to return funds that belong to the people. Many people move or change addresses and fail to update their contact information with the County. Our job then is to try to find those entitled to refunds. Our announcement today is the culmination of many months of working to return the funds to their rightful owners,” McAllister said. “We are hopeful that they will hear or see our announcements and take time to check our website to claim their funds.”

Today’s notice is to give claimants an additional 60 days (**Monday, September 23, 2013**) to file a claim for their money. Final written notices have been sent to the last known mailing addresses for each refund owed, however many notices have been returned or checks have not been cashed.

The County Treasurer-Tax Collector’s office has **1288 unclaimed accounts, which amount to nearly \$300,000 in funds available**. Of that amount, \$130,000 are unclaimed property tax refunds and another \$156,000 are from various County Departments that consumers have dealt with during the past four years. The lowest amount available is \$10.01 and the highest is \$9,109.54 to Valley Center Investment, LLC.

Current state law allows countywide monies that remain unclaimed for more than three years and property tax refunds that are unclaimed for more than four years to be turned over to the County’s General Fund.
