193 San Diego County Properties Set For Auction Today!

San Diego, CA... San Diego County Treasurer-Tax Collector Dan McAllister announced today that **193 Tax Defaulted Properties** are scheduled to be sold at the 2015 Property Tax Sale Auction. This event is being held today at the *San Diego Convention Center (111 West Harbor Drive, Ballroom 20A) in downtown San Diego*. The property auction is being held in an effort to collect \$2,166,512.00 in unpaid property taxes, including penalties and fees.

“Today we have 18 improved properties, 114 unimproved parcels and 61 timeshares for auction,” stated McAllister. “The owners had until 5:00 PM yesterday to pay the defaulted taxes and delinquent charges to avoid their properties from being auctioned off today.”

Bidders for today’s event purchased registration packets for \$50 to be eligible for participation in the bidding. “Some years we have incredible bargains for bidders involved in this annual auction,” said McAllister. Today’s event deems to be no exception to the opportunities to obtain property in San Diego County.

Under California State law, the Treasurer-Tax Collector may sell any or all portions of properties that have been in default for five years. In December 2014, the Board of Supervisors approved 481 properties, including timeshares, for this auction.

Minimum bids are set based on the total amount of back taxes, penalties and sales costs. The successful bidder may take possession of a property after making a payment in full and after the Tax Deed to Purchaser has been recorded.
